

PLANTING & GROWING HACKS

- PLANT DAHLIAS, GLADIOLUS, AND CANNAS NOW THEY THRIVE IF PLANTED ONCE FROST RISK IS PAST.
- **DEADHEAD TULIPS AND DAFFODILS**, BUT LEAVE THE GREEN FOLIAGE TO DIE BACK NATURALLY THEY NEED IT TO STORE ENERGY FOR NEXT YEAR.

PEST & WILDLIFE HACKS

- PLANT MARIGOLDS AND NASTURTIUMS AROUND VEGGIE GARDENS TO DETER APHIDS AND RABBITS NATURALLY.
- USE CRUSHED EGGSHELLS AROUND PLANTS LIKE HOSTAS TO DETER SLUGS AND SNAILS.

🥮 OTHER SMART MOVES

- SHARPEN AND OIL GARDEN TOOLS TO SAVE TIME AND EFFORT THROUGHOUT THE BUSY SEASON.
